International Psycho-Oncology Society (IPOS)

Founded in 1984, the International Psycho-Oncology Society (IPOS) was created to foster international multidisciplinary communication about clinical, educational and research issues that relate to the subspecialty of psycho-oncology and two primary psychosocial dimensions of cancer:

- Response of patients, families and staff to cancer and its treatment at all stages;
- Psychological, social and behavioral factors that influence tumor progression and survival.

IPOS has members in more than 65 countries. Members are current professionals (physicians, epidemiologists, psychologists, nurses, social workers, social scientists and other professionals at the Masters or Doctoral level), students and individuals with a keen interest in oncology. - **Associate membership:** any individual that demonstrates an interest in psycho-oncology.
- **Early Career Psycho-Oncology Professionals (ECPP) membership:** individuals who are within three years of his/her ultimate degree and is a practicing professional.
- **Members-in-Training membership:** those in training to become physicians, epidemiologists, psychologists, nurses, social workers and social scientists are eligible for this membership category.
